School & Community

Yantai Huasheng International School (YHIS) is an independent, coeducational, tuition-based, international school located in Yantai, China. YHIS is Yantai's first English language international school licensed by the Shandong Provincial Government. Since the beginning of the school in 2016, the school's enrollment on the first day of school has grown significantly from 121 in 2016, and to 166 in 2018, ranging from our Early Childhood program through Grade 12. To support our international community who may come at different times of the year, admissions happen on a rolling basis with the school year beginning in the middle of August and ending in mid-June of the following year.

Curriculum

YHIS offers an American-based curriculum based on the AERO standards, with an international focus, providing a solid foundation in both education and character. Our curriculum prepares students to achieve their goals and to impact their communities around the world.

As part of the iSC system of schools, the curriculum undergoes a review every five years. A thorough review process is conducted over a period of time in five stages. Each school year, two to three subject areas are reviewed at the iSC-China level. Selected individuals from all iSC-China schools participate in the curriculum review.

School Calendar

The school year generally starts in the middle of August and ends in the beginning of June. It is divided into two semesters of two quarters each. There are approximately 180 school days on the school calendar.

Affiliation & Accreditation

YHIS is actively pursuing accreditation. In November 2017, YHIS received WASC initial visit, and YHIS has been granted WASC candidacy with effect from February 2018.

International Schools Consortium (iSC) is a nonprofit organization that, since 1986, has offered excellent academic programs to meet the intellectual, physical, and emotional needs of students. iSC has six schools in China — in Chengdu, Qingdao, Wuhan, Wuxi, Tianjin, and Yantai — one school in the UAE, and helps to support various other educational initiatives globally. iSC is a multi-school program, enabling students and teachers to participate in system-wide programs where they can interact with others outside of their immediate school.




Co-Curricular Activities



Graduation Requirements

24 credits are required for graduation. Each successfully completed course in high school receives 0.5 credit per semester. A failing grade does not earn credit. The minimum credit requirements for graduation include the following:

- English - 4 credits
- Social Studies - 3 credits
- Science - 3 credits
- Math - 3 credits
- Foreign Language - 2 credits
- Physical Education/Health - 2 credits
- Fine Arts - 1 credit
- Religious Studies - 0.5 per semester enrolled
- Electives - minimum 2 credits

Grading Scale

A grade point average (GPA) is derived for high school students by ascribing a point value to a letter grade as follows:

Students enrolled in AP courses will receive a weighted GPA of 0.5 points more for their letter grade of C- or above.



In 2018, five students took a total of 7 AP® exams. All of our student who took the exam achieved a score of 4 and 5 for all courses, far exceeding that of the global average and China. These strong AP results reflect the good learning by our students and the excellent work of our teachers.
